Abstract: This presentation will discuss whether voting accessibility have been equally distributed to different groups of citizens by race, gender, economic status, and locations of residence, particularly focusing on who are more likely to vote early including Sunday. We used the 2008 election data to examine socioeconomic characteristics of those who voted early and on Sunday. The findings from this research could be used as guidance to policymakers on how to enhance the level of equity in voting accessibility when designing the voting schedule.
