Public Sector Infrastructure and Social Equity in the Implementation and Enforcement of LGBT Rights

Abstract: Public organizations are responsible for the implementation and enforcement of public policy, including policies related to the protections of rights for the LGBT community. This presentation, based on an article to be published in the spring symposium in the Journal of Public Management and Social Policy, will look at issues related to the rights of the LGBT community and the public administration infrastructure in place to protect these rights. Issues of social equity arise on several fronts based on differences in policies across levels of government and regional differences. Despite recent progress in recognition of LGBT rights, there are still several public administration issues that need to be addressed. This could be part of a larger panel on at-risk or vulnerable communities.
